<u>Computer/Internet access</u> is available for card holders in good standing. See librarian to sign up.

Loan Periods:

Books: 3 weeks DVDs: 1 week CDs: 3 weeks Materials from other libraries may have different loan policies.

Adults may borrow 20 books at a time, with higher quantities at the discretion of the librarian.

Juveniles (through eighth grade) may check out 5 items at one time. Two DVDs may be borrowed with higher quantities at the discretion of the librarian.

Children must have approval of parents to check out items. Parents are ultimately responsible for items checked out on their children's cards.

Items may be renewed in person, online, or by telephone. Items may be returned through the book slot in the front door or in the drop box in the hall if the library is closed.

Overdue Fines: The Unadilla Public Library is a completely fine free library.

* This does not apply to lost, assumed lost, damaged items, or fines from other libraries.
